

The ups and downs of exterior spaces make life easier and safer when they glow with built-in, LED lighting.

LED technology also allows designers

to bring new shapes and styles to the customers. Different geometric shapes exist, as well as different shades of white. "It gives a different feel and mood, and these lights can stand up to the Colorado weather." Nestor states that the lights offer about 50,000 hours of light that can translate to seven or eight years of life.

Enjoying the Colorado night sky is a part of the Western experience, but greater development means more city lights. To counter that effect, Dark Sky lighting is an exciting trend that has moved from the mountains into the city. The light source is an LED light recessed into the roof of the lantern. "All you get is a glow. It is confined to a limited space and produces less light pollution."

Jackson says customers want not only curb appeal but clean lines. Nestor also says that one of the biggest requests they get is to light the front of the home, particularly the walkways, pathways and even driveways.

"One of the most interesting pieces that we are seeing more and more is lighting driveways with lights that are recessed into the driveway. You can drive over them, and they offer a nice way to light up the path into the garage area."

Brandon Donovan, owner of Colorado



"Nobody wants to be that neighbor whose sprinklers go off during a storm," Donovan says with a laugh. "Our system can be connected to weather trackers." The sprinkler can be set up so that in the event of a rain forecast it will shut off. Watering certain zones of the yard while leaving other areas temporarily dry is another option.

Donovan notes the crossover appeal between interior and exterior design. "With our product, you can adjust all the lights in the house, or just the porch lights if you want to stagger shut-off times. You can decide to have certain lights come on during your commute home. People can even control their shades on different sides of the house remotely."

There is little doubt that this is a
